


China's perspective on Europe's standardisation approach

- China eyes Europe for its ongoing standardisation reforn
 - The TTIP effect: identifying the political potential
 - Industrial policymaking: from protectionism to innovation promotion
 - US or EU? Trying to take the best of it "with Chinese characteristics"
- "China Standards 2035", "National Standards Strategy" and the Belt and Road Initiative
 - Streamlining China's standards system
 - Maintain state permeation
 - Power projection

The Chinese state-permeated approach to technical standardisation


- Maintain state-tier, transfer mandatory into voluntary standards
- Permeate market-tier: private-state distinction?; select pild SDOs; strengthen national champions; front runner syste
- Competition over high standards move up the value chain: party-state serves as "referee"





How to meet the "China challenge"?

China: growing, but not dominating



How to meet the "China challenge"?

Strengthen the system, not abandoning it!



- Advocate a nonpolitical approach to standardisation
- Align with likeminded partners to push back against China's state-steered standardisation



Fragmentation and bifurcation

- Facilitate Chinese socialisation into existing international standards institutions
 - Insist on international frameworks and reciprocity



- Improve the EU's innovation and standardisation environment
- •Better coordinate EU standards efforts and support knowledge generation and dissemination
