

Construction Products - Fit for the Future



- Very low number of citations in OJEU
 - → **Setback** in a sector essential for revival of economy
- Need for state-of-the-art harmonized Standards
 - Smooth transition from Mandates to Standardization Requests
 - Clear and stable guidance on requirements
 - Consistency and alignment of European Policies and legislation
- Assess the cost of no-Standards for SMEs
